

FAQ for Administrators: High-Dosage Tutoring

How does High-Dosage Tutoring help address learning gaps?

A [2021 meta-analysis](#) conducted by the Annenberg Institute showed that tutoring could “meaningfully increase learning for a wide variety of K-12 students” by approximately 3 to 15 months.

How many students get tutored at the same time?

A maximum of four students will participate in high-impact tutoring with a single tutor.

How are tutors selected?

The selection process is rigorous. Tutors must:

1. Pass subject-matter exams
2. Verify their education
3. Be fingerprinted and undergo background checks at the county, state, and federal level
4. Participate in interviews and training
5. Engage in ongoing session quality reviews and receive feedback from our team of instructional specialists

Will administrators have access to data?

Yes, on the Administrator Dashboard you will be able to monitor data and pull reports.

How long and how often are the sessions?

Sessions take place during the school day, throughout a semester or school year, about 3 times a week at a scheduled time. Each session lasts 30 or 45 minutes.

Will students work with the same tutor each time?

Yes, students will be working with the same tutor for every session. Once the schedule is established, a tutor will be waiting to work with their assigned group of students at the appointed time.

Are sessions safe?

Yes. Tutor.com complies with all applicable safety and security regulations.
