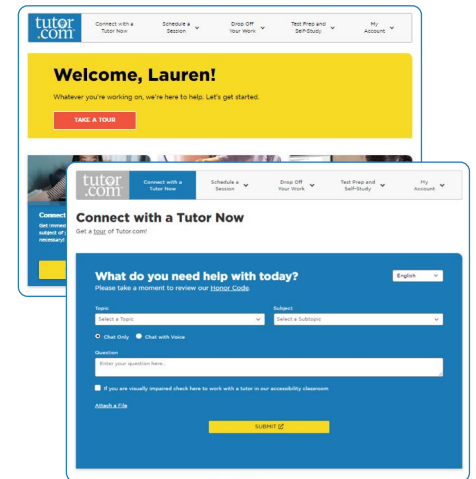
Ask a Question

Click **Connect with a Tutor Now** at the top-left corner or the **CONNECT NOW** button. Then, select your language, topic, subject, and grade level.

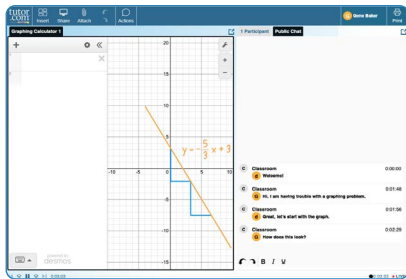
Ask your question. You can share a specific problem or let the tutor know what concept you need help with. Here are some examples of questions you might ask:

- *Can you help me format my paper in MLA?*

Get Connected with a Tutor



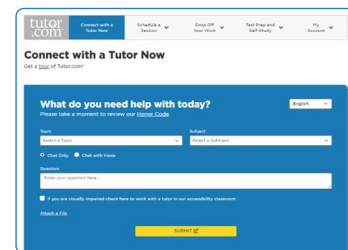
Click on the SUBMIT button to quickly connect with an expert tutor. The tutoring classroom will pop up in a new window.
